

Guidelines for selection of Club Member of the Year

Goal:

- To recognise a Club member who:
 - has given exemplary service in enhancing the enjoyment of the Club for its members
 - has provided selfless ongoing commitment to the Club
 - is seen as an example for members and recognised for demonstrating the Club's values of:
 - heritage
 - friendship
 - vitality
 - pride in place
 - community engagement

Selection Criteria:

- Must be a financial member of the Club with a minimum of 5 years standing
- Cannot be a current serving member of the Board of Club
- Cannot be a Life Member of Club
- Must have enhanced the enjoyment of a significant number of Club members over a number of years
- Not restricted to swimmers or those assisting in swimming events
- Paid services are not to be included in the criteria
- Must be nominated by a current Club member, with two seconders
- Can be nominated by any Club member, whether or not on the Board or Membership Committee
- Award will be a recognition of outstanding service and will not necessarily be made annually

Selection Process

- The selection will be made by the Membership Committee with a recommendation forwarded to the Board by March each year.
- Nominations do not have to be unanimous at either membership committee or Board level. A simple majority is sufficient.
- Successful candidate to be announced to members and award presented at the annual prize-giving event.
